Brief description of Bio Centre

A center of excellence for bioresouces and a knowledge center for promoting organic farming. Bio Centre was established in January 2001 at Hulimavu Horticultural Farm, Bengaluru, under the aegis of the Department of Horticulture, Govt. of Karnataka. The center has state-of-the-art laboratory facilities for tissue culture, DNA Finger Printing, food analysis, plant nutrition, and phytosanitary, quality testing for organic products and heavy metal and residue analysis in horticultural produce. The center also has green houses for plant propagation, mother plant orchards and conservatories for horticultural Germplasm.

Objectives of the Visit:

- Seed saving, potting, re-potting of kitchen & ornamental plants and practicals.
- Propagation of plants
- Production and supply of bio inputs like bio fertilizers, bio pesticides, vermicomposting and bio manures.


